

3. *Tenshi*

The Realm of Potentiality

*Imagine absolute nothingness,
complete non-existence.*

*Imagine no such thing as time and space,
absolutely no world at all.*

*From here, there is only potentiality.
This is Tenshi.*

Life, Being (L,B) creates its own classification and explanation of things. With this it defines some words in its own way. Some words will already have strong definitions in people's mind and understanding.

In a thought experiment, if you imagine removing everything that you know from the world then you will get a picture of an empty world. When we remove everything from the world, in our mind's eye, we see a huge amount of empty space; but we must remove the empty space too. While you are at it, remove time as well. We want everything gone! Now that everything is gone there still remains the chance that all things could be; and this is tenshi! Tenshi is short for po-Tenshi-ality. Tenshi is a word created to give more meaning to the word 'potentiality'. They can still hold the same meaning... it depends on how you define them.

Tenshi is used in place of the word 'potentiality' because the idea of Life, Being needs a word that can differ from the usual understanding. I hope 'tenshi' can show you something that you have always known but never held in your thought or heart. Even though tenshi is a new word, in this philosophy, tenshi and potentiality are the same thing because once you see potentiality you understand how amazing it is.

People can have an intuitive understanding of tenshi but it can be a hard to put into words other than saying it is what is left when all else is gone. In this world where everything is not gone, what is 'tenshi'?

I exist in time, I am being, and I feel as though tenshi is in my world. Tenshi is a thing that is 'being'. But tenshi is the unrealised side of existence. Once something is realised it is no longer a potential: it's an 'actual'. I would have to say that I classify tenshi as 'being', but this is just how it feels to me. 'Being' has a time-related aspect and yet tenshi exists without time. Can it exist without being, while still being?

At this point many people may start to think of god (God). When I explain tenshi, many see it as being the same as god. In L,B tenshi is NOT god. However, because of the nature of tenshi, it could be. It has no restriction, no boundary, and is an inert ultimate freedom. It is Beautiful, and maybe it is god.

Aristotelian philosophy (Aristotle is a philosopher 384–322 BC) talks of potentiality and actuality like one is being and one is not. Tenshi is an actuality because I can name it, but it is also the source of actuality - and this sounds ridiculous; but think about it. Tenshi is not, however, the things of actuality! It does not have a physical aspect, and yet it is the origin of everything in existence.

Everything in our world is a potential that has happened. The question is... what ingredients, what mechanism and what path does a potential require to make the journey to becoming real? We pay no attention to the process of the tenshi-to-reality transition because it is the world we live in. We are desensitised to it. It is like the proverbial fish not seeing the water it swims in.

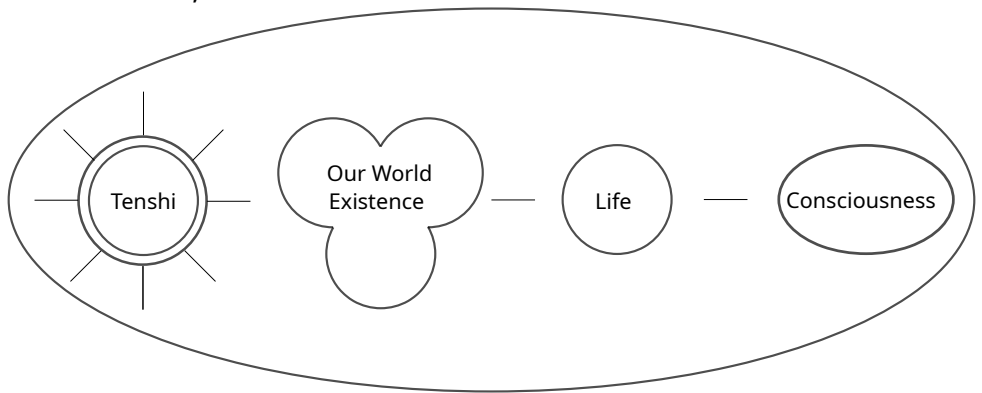
But what is the bridge between tenshi and reality? And how does a 'possibility' move to become 'real'? Sometimes it seems to happen by accident, and sometimes it seems that things are happening according to a design.

Mostly we do not even notice the tenshi to reality process and nor should we, it is like noticing our heart beating, but we can be aware of our heart beating and we can be aware of tenshi. If we bring the understanding of tenshi and the PCEs into our consciousness then we can start to implement ways utilise this knowledge. If we bring our attention to the mechanism of reality, we are able to create new possibilities for the machinery of existence, which will ultimately lead to new realities.

Everything in our universe has resulted from a potential that has found a path to reality. It is from the endless pool of potentials that planets, stars, galaxies, life and consciousness have manifested. The universe is manifesting from different potentials in every moment, and 'manifestation' itself is a potential. This world has sprung and it continues to spring from the endless reservoir of the *realm of potentiality - the tenshi*.

Our world is an expression of tenshi. Life started as a potential and all it needed was an opportunity to become real.

After life had become a reality, the potential of consciousness then existed; it became real too.
